- 1) Roy Skelding welcomed attendees and all agreed to follow the usual format for Safer neighborhood meetings until handover to Susan later during discussions.
- 2) Minutes of the meeting Safer Neighbourhood Panel held Tuesday 4 October 2011 circulated.
 - Team agreed notes of these PACT meetings should be displayed on Council's website and in parish magazines.
- 3) Apologies - Malcolm Hogg, Mal Rowland.
- 4) Winchester City Council Safer Neighborhoods Perspective
 - Fly Tipping - The Neighbourhood Warden Team does not have the facility to remove but will continue to visit sites in an attempt to identify source.
 - WCC Clive Eliston, team leader to meet with Parish Clerks. Team of 5 who mainly work in the city but may be released for the wider Parish areas if need arises.
 - Staff reduction now means a greater reliance on police for data analyzing
 - Next bulletin due early February
- 5) **Priorities**
 - Swanmore - Antisocial behaviour and Road Traffic Offences plus litter problems, particularly during term time. It was suggested to send letter to Swanmore Liaison, Pcso to liaise with school, Doug Ross deals with waste clearance, enquire about a possible litter pick or organize independently.
 - Shedfield - Antisocial behaviour, Burglary and Road Traffic Offences
- 6) **Community Speed Watch**

Swanmore volunteers begin tomorrow

Noted that team are disappointed that Shedfield could not offer financial support. Expected number for a team between 3 to 6 members; police may be able to offer funding for equipment before the end of this financial year. Shedfield may apply subject to sufficient volunteers wishing to run this scheme.

8) POLICE ADVICE

- **Swanmore** - 10 Reports of Anti-social behaviour and 3 Road Traffic incidents 2 of which related to unlit parked vehicles.
- **Shedfield/Shirrell Heath/Waltham Chase** - 4 Burglaries; 1 dwelling and 3 outbuildings, stables, nurseries and a garage. 7 Road Traffic incidents 5 collisions, a minor injury at Heathlands; Blind Lane; Crossroads at Waltham Chase; High Street Shirrell Heath; Cyclist at Frith Lane and a stolen vehicle.
- PC Mel Attwood is now available for more hours that will include cover for Swanmore and Shedfield.
- The **101** number will now take priority for non-urgent reporting of incidents to police.
- Future PACT meetings should include a representative from each Council, Neighbourhood Watch and members of public to be held at alternate venues. Information is also available on www.crimereports.co.uk
- Brian Turner's role to assist NeighbourhoodWatch (NW) in the Meon Valley, representing the area at 6 monthly Winchester District meetings with the Police, and 3 monthly Hampshire NW Association meetings. Working with Police, Trading Standards etc.
- Neighbourhood Watch needs more support in the represented parishes. Current known NW schemes: Shirrell Heath none, Shedfield 1, Swanmore 7, Waltham Chase 4?
- The emailed weekly crime report from Bishops Waltham will almost certainly stop in March. The new Crime Reports system (www.crimereports.co.uk), although helpful, does not yet provide sufficient detail on individual incidents to satisfy NW requirements.
- Neighbourhood Watch emphasises support for the older and more vulnerable members of the community.
- A Winchester NW website is under development. In the meantime some advice on NW, safety and security is at www.denmeadnw.org.
