



## WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL GRANTS FOR NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANISATIONS - 2018/19

### **Small Grants - up to £500 - Deadline: noon 15 June**

Grants of up to £500 are available to not-for-profit and voluntary organisations in the district to support their work. This grant stream is for one off activities or pieces of equipment. You may wish to apply for a health related activity, a new/additional piece of equipment for a sports club, promotional material for an arts event/project, or a community activity.

We are encouraging applicants to apply for a Small Grant for local community events or celebrations of the Armistice Day Centenary Anniversary on 11 November 2018.

### **Small Project Grant Scheme - Up to £3000 - Deadline: noon 15 June**

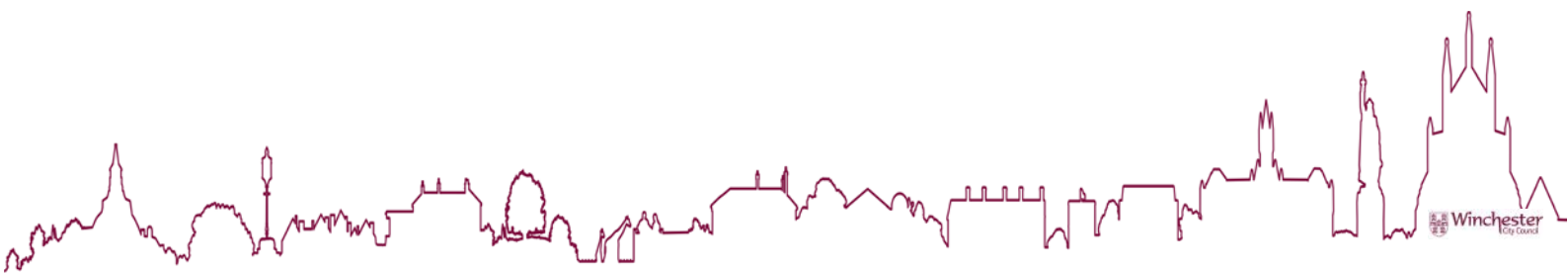
For grants towards the cost of one-off projects, specialised equipment, start ups and improvements or construction of facilities. Replacement, maintenance or like-for-like items are not funded under this scheme as they are deemed a core running cost.

Please note that applicants must secure a minimum of 25% of the total project cost from their own resources. It is anticipated that this will include a mix of the organisation's own funding; fundraising proceeds; other grants; a contribution from the Parish Council/Meeting or Town Forum as appropriate etc.

Applicants must provide a statement of support for their project from their Parish Council/Meeting or Ward Member. You can find out who your local Ward Member is on our website:

### **Town Forum Small Grants - upto £500 - Deadline: noon 15 August**

This grant is specifically for organisations serving the five unparished Wards of Winchester, although open to partnership funding with surrounding parishes (e.g. Badger Farm & Olivers Battery).

For one-off pieces of expenditure on projects, equipment and other items which will help your organisation to do more, to reach more people, to provide better services or to try something different. Organisations applying will need to demonstrate community benefit.

Applicants must seek support from their local Ward Member. This can be a short statement, email or letter. Check your Ward Member at <http://www.winchester.gov.uk/elections/ward-map>
