

## **C&C Minutes 20-04-20 – Appendix A – ‘One-Off’ and ‘As and When’ Tasks 2020 – 2024 Agreed.**

### **ONE-OFF**

- Check, clear and repair all ditches and bunds to prevent access to the Common by vehicles
- Clear vegetation from garage behind cemetery; repair door, install lock, fix leaks
- Plant new trees along Botley Road and Winchester Road; ensure saplings are watered, mulched, weeded, protected
- Re-treat bracken (Asulox banned January 2020: appeal delayed by coronavirus)
- Clear culvert under B2177 (F-B)
- Full tree survey and management plan with Open Spaces (over three years)
- Raise crown on selected trees on G, H, J, K

### **AS AND WHEN**

- Removal of scrub on B, C, F, G, H, J, K
- Clear invasive laurel along north-eastern boundary of F, and restore water courses
- Clear scrub and restore water course at former sewage farm (south end of J)
- Clear scrub and restore channels and smaller pond on F adjacent to B2177
- Re-open water channel and reduce dense holly across K
- Update map of areas: B & E just woodland; new area M behind nursery north of stream; merge H & J and extend to track; reduce K to east of track; annotate Management Plan and HBIC survey
- Rename lettered areas with names (e.g. Quagg End, Nature Reserve, Wetland, Hazel Coppice, Church View, Shid Wood, etc.). Make laminated copies
- Complete history research and install information boards with maps and suggested walk
- Re-open path from Shedfield Footpath 20 to rear of Sam's Hotel
- Complete clearance of stream/ditch/Shid (area B) from B2177 culvert past footpath 7 (from church) to A334
- Monitor heather on scrapes, add scrapes as appropriate
- Renew all gorse by removing degenerate stands
- Control invasive birch by tree-popping
- Bat survey, reptile survey, dormice survey
- Lay reptile survey refugia
- Identify remaining Commoners
- Remove parrots feather in double pond
- Clear out double pond
- Treat rhododendron regrowth chemically
- Cut down and treat laurel and American wild cherry
- Review bollards on Biddenfield Lane, Pricketts Hill
- Revise management plan (2022)
